As you all know, we celebrated our 50th Anniversary (1959-2009) during our March meeting. All members get the 2-coin set for FREE when attending the meetings!

The club marked this special event with a custom-designed Elongated Coin set. The coin was designed by the Club's President, Oded Paz, engraved and rolled by Brad Ream of Rockville, IN.

Only 100 cents were rolled on 1959 Copper Cents + 100 cents on regular copper cents. A special edition of only 20 sets were made on all available U.S. coins. The set includes the 1959 and copper Cents, Nickel, Dime, Quarter, Half Dollar and Presidential Dollar. All coins have stained backs, showing the reverse side of the coin (except for the 1959 Cent, which shows the obverse/ year) – this set is SOLD OUT!!!

You can purchase additional Cent sets for \$2.50 (postpaid). Members can get additional coins AT THE MEETING ONLY for only \$2.

EXCITING NEWS – The bottom line is that not only the club did not have to pay for these, but the total sales totaled \$426 and the cost was \$350 so the club made a small PROFIT of \$76 on these elongated coins – YIPPEE!!!!!


