February's Program...

The Story of the S.S. Republic

The S.S. Republic was a Civil War-era steamship that sank in 1865 while carrying a large cargo of silver and gold coins. The shipwreck was discovered by Odyssey Marine Exploration in 2003. The archaeological excavation conducted during the 2003-2004 excavation seasons was accomplished entirely through the use of advanced robotics and cuttingedge technologies and was the first of its kind ever performed at such depths. Over 51,000 U.S. gold and silver coins were ultimately recovered from the Republic wreck site. Our program will feature a portion of a National Geographic video focusing on the recovery of the coins from the S.S. Republic. We will also have a few of the actual coins recovered from the S.S. Republic on display at our meeting!

Glendale Coin Club 55th Anniversary Medals...

As previously mentioned, this March will be the 55th Anniversary of the Glendale Coin Club. We have commissioned Daniel Carr to strike commemorative medals. Daniel Carr is the designer of the New York and Rhode Island statehood quarters and his company owns a surplus coin press from the Denver Mint. His works are widely known and are highly sought after by collectors. Medals will be struck in copper, silver and gold. Final orders and payment will be due at our February 14 meeting and we expect delivery at our March 14 meeting. The obverse features the reverse design of the 1925 California Diamond Jubilee Half Dollar surrounded by our club name in incused lettering. The reverse recreates the 55/55 from the 1955 Doubled Die Obverse Lincoln Cent and features the 1959-2014 dual date.

All active club members who attend a meeting during 2014 will receive one copper medal **FREE**!

Additional medals are priced as follows:

39mm Copper Medal = \$10 each

39mm **Silver** .999 One Ounce Medal ("ONE TROY OZ. 999 SILVER" marked on edge) = **\$30 each**

39mm **Gold** .999 50 Gram Medal ("50 GRAMS 999+ GOLD" marked on edge) approx. 1.6 troy oz. gold = **\$2400 each**
