Most coin collectors will agree that the top two professional coin certification and grading companies in the market today are the Professional Coin Grading Service (PCGS) and the Numismatic Guaranty Corporation (NGC). But most coin collectors do not know exactly how each company does their job. We will be showing two short videos that will reveal the inner workings of each company and will give you a behind the scenes look at how your high -end coins are certified as genuine and how they are assigned a numerical grade. Additionally, Jay Robinson will be giving us a brief overview of the different styles of plastic holders each company has used over the years. As you may know, this March will be the 55th Anniversary of the Glendale Coin Club. To celebrate that occasion, we are having a special commemorative medal struck. The medal will be produced by Daniel Carr, the designer of the New York and Rhode Island state quarters. Medals will be struck in copper, silver and gold. We will be ordering the medals at the time of our February meeting and will have them delivered by our March anniversary meeting. Prices of the medals have not yet been finalized. The obverse features the reverse design of the 1925 California Diamond Jubilee Half Dollar surrounded by the name of our club and can be seen on page one. The reverse recreates the 55/55 from the 1955 Doubled Die Obverse Lincoln Cent and features the 1959-2014 dual
