The Short Life of the Half Cent By: David Hyams

This month's program will be on half cents which were minted from 1793 to 1857. There were several designs of half cents during this period and they were not issued in all years. The half cent is the lowest denomination of coin ever struck by the United States and mintages were often very low. Because of that, half cent coins have always been popular with collectors.










2017 Glendale Coin Club Overstrikes...

As previously mentioned, we are unable to have Daniel Carr make club medals for us this year given his current workload. Typically smaller clubs like ours do not have custom medals made every year. Daniel Carr has asked us to hold off on doing a new medal until our next big anniversary in 2019. He did a great job with our 2014-2016 club medals and I look forward to the next medal we have made.

In discussing the matter further with Daniel Carr, we may be able to use our existing die to overstrike coins. So, we are planning to use our existing obverse die of the 1925 California Diamond Jubliee Half Dollar (see Page 1) to overstrike 2017-dated copper rounds and silver eagles. This will be a quick and easy way to have Daniel Carr make us some neat pieces for our club that are dated 2017.

All active club members who attend a meeting during 2017 will receive one copper overstrike **FREE**! (1 per person, 2 per family membership)

Additional pieces are priced as follows:

Overstrike of 2017 **Copper** Walker Zombucks = **\$12.50 each**

Overstrike of 2017 One Ounce U.S. **Silver** Eagle = **\$27.50 each**

Final **orders and payment** will be **due** by our **August 11** meeting and we expect delivery by our October meeting.

Please note that the final prices are subject to adjustment in the event silver prices substantially change by the time our order is placed in mid-August.


