There are many places on the Internet to buy many great coins. There are major auction houses, dealer websites, online message boards and of course eBay. In many of these online transactions you are required to send money to a complete stranger you have never dealt with and to trust that they will send you what you ordered as advertised. While the majority of online sellers are honest (otherwise they would not in business for long), there are enough bad guys out there for you to exercise some caution when shopping online. 
