

Thus it will be seen that the head of the American Indian, which has hitherto adorned the face of the small copper cents, has been done away with, being superseded by the the bust of Abraham Lincoln.

The Lincoln cent is the idea of former President Roosevelt, who commissioned Victor Drenner, of New York, to design the piece. In speaking of his work Mr. Drenner said:

"If you will observe the Lincom cent carefully you will see that I have made him smiling. I wanted to show the sunshine as well as the goodness of his life. My intention has been to present a situation in which Lincoln might have appeared at his best. Finally I imagined him as talking to a child. That is the face on the coin. A man or woman is natural when speaking to a child. When adults converse they are usually on guard, but in talking to children, their faces relax and are at their best.

"I am glad the head will appear on the cent, the piece of money most familiar to the masses. It was Lincoln who said that God must love the common people because He made so many of them. I had rather have his head on the cent than on the \$20 gold piece."


