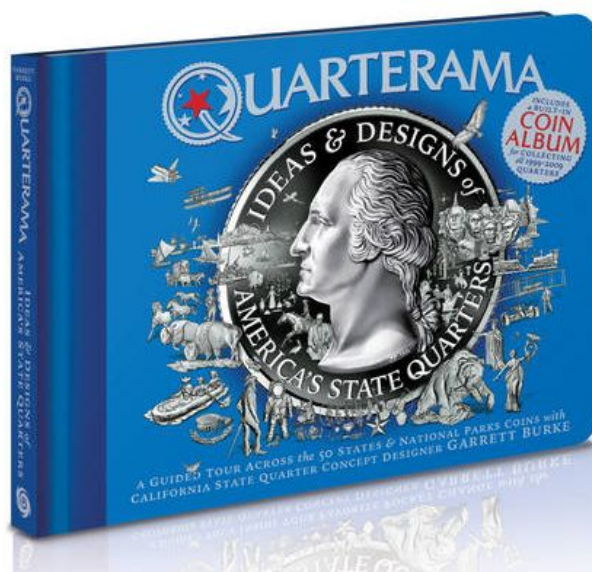

Garrett Burke will be speaking to us on the California State Quarter. His creative fingerprints are visible across popular culture. You've probably already held one of his ideas in your hands.

Topping 8,300+ entries, Garrett's coin concept honoring John Muir in Yosemite Valley was selected to be the California State Quarter. 140 million people collect these coins as part of the U.S. Mint's popular 50 State Quarters®.

Before developing a tiny piece of American history, Garrett crafted movie posters, art, logos, and packaging for Hollywood brands including "Star Wars," "James Bond," "Harry Potter," "Nickelodeon," and "Dr. Seuss." His design work has been recognized by the Library of Congress, American Corporate Identity, international design annuals and books, and the Hollywood Reporter Key Art Awards. A recipient of the John Muir Association's "John Muir Conservation Award," Garrett twice designed commemorative medals for the American Numismatic Association's "World's Fair of Money" and received their prestigious "Art Award for Excellence in Medallion Sculpture." He was twice featured on the PBS-TV interview series "Between the Lines" to discuss the 50 State Quarters.

Raised in Philadelphia & New York, Garrett is an honors graduate of Pratt Institute's School of Art & Design and
