## October's Program

Our very own Greg Burns will be the speaker. He has been a member of GCC for almost 20 years. He got to us by trying about a half-dozen other clubs in SoCal but chose GCC because it was so friendly. I was impressed and stayed with GCC since the president at that time, Bill Randolph, always went effusively out of his way to greet new guests and make them feel comfortable. Collecting caught me in early 60's when I had a penny-board and similar folders, just like each of my friends. Many drifted off to other things, but numismatics stayed with me.

The program will be the Silver Coin Quiz from the August 1955 issue of the *The Numismatist* which was contributed by Stuart Mosher who was one of the best known numismatists of his era. In 1945 and 1946 Richard Yeoman of Whitman Publishing Company hired him to create what became *A Guide Book of United States Coins* (aka: The Red Book). When the book became a reality in 1946, with a cover date of 1947, Mosher was given the first copy. He was also the numismatic curator for the Mint Collection in the Smithsonian Institution.
