The club now meets at the Carriage Inn/Denny's, located at the southwest corner of Burbank Blvd and Sepulveda Blvd. - This is a great spot with ample parking and freeway access.

DID YOU KNOW THAT: There was a bank in Glendale that issued National Bank Notes? The charter number is 10412. The First National Bank in Glendale, CA first released in 1913 a series of 1902 \$10 blue seal notes. The series was issued from 1913 until 1928. A portrait of William McKinley is on the front side of the note. There is a big blue overprint of the charter number stamped twice. Some 1902 \$10 bills will have a large blue letter S, W, P, M, N, or E printed on them. The letter changes or is missing based on the area of issue. Some currency from this bank is very rare. The current value of any \$10 dollar blue seal is based on condition and serial number of the bill. <http://rarenationalbanknotes.com>
